"On the Beat" with Sgt Bron Umbras, Acting OIC Mundijong Station

Hello to all of our ewatchers

For the month of May 2015, a total of 150 incidents were recorded for the Mundijong Police Sub-District. This continues a decreasing trend from March and April 2015. This encompasses a variety of both crime and general incidents, including traffic crashes, burglaries, domestic violence, stealing and drug related activities.

The 'hot spot' for reported incidents was Byford, where 80 crime, traffic or general incidents were reported, 14 in Serpentine, 12 in Oakford, 11 in Wandi and a handful for our remaining areas.

The 'hot spots' for burglaries were Byford (14) and Wandi, Oakford, Casuarina and Serpentine (three each) with the total monthly attempted or actual burglaries across our 15 suburbs/areas at 31.

We have seen an increase in stealings from parked cars, in the newer residential areas in western Byford and the Honeywood Estate in Wandi. Don't rely on trying to claim stolen items on insurance. Please secure your car in a garage or remove your valuables if you park your car on a driveway, verge or car park.

In the last two weeks we have also seen a trend of day time burglaries in homes in the newer residential areas in western Byford, particularly, at times when you would expect lots of cars and people around with a high risk of being seen or caught.

Over the past few months we have achieved some great successes in arresting and charging people with burglary and theft offences, particularly from homes under construction in Byford. Details of this was included in the local Examiner newspaper on 4 June 2015 and highlighted our partnership with the B.U.S.T.E.D program, which is an initiative within the housing construction industry to stop theft from building sites and catch and charge those responsible.

Further to that article we have arrested and charged:

- a 44 year old woman from Byford with Aggravated Burglary and Assault after allegedly forcing her way into a home in Oldbury on 29 May 2015
- a 42 year old woman from Darling Downs with Burglary and Stealing allegedly committed on a home in Cardup on 27 May 2015
- a 30 year old woman and a 25 year old man from Cockburn Central with the alleged theft of a chainsaw from a Cardup man and alleged fraudulent pawning

- 43 year old woman from Oakford on two arrest warrants, who has 15 charges before the courts including four alleged burglaries and numerous alleged stealings, she was remanded in custody
- On 9 June 2015 Kwinana Police arrested and charged a 31 year old woman from Serpentine with Burglary, Stealing of a Motor Vehicle and Fraud

Parking Laws within the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale



As the Shire has evolved from a rural environment to the beginnings of a thriving metropolis, concerns relating to parking issues have been identified as increases in population bring more traffic to the area.

In 2014 a Shire review found the Shire's Parking Facilities Local Law was inadequate and it has been replaced with a more relevant Parking Facilities Local Law.

The intent of the Parking Facilities Local Law is to provide guidance and a relevant statutory environment and enforcement process in

respect to the management and control of parking and parking facilities. This Parking Facilities Local Law assists in the safety and wellbeing of residents, visitors and the wider community.

Immediate areas of concern for Rangers are:

- traffic and parking in and around school zones with a focus on drop off and pick up times
- disabled parking and rightful use for disabled persons
- parking of trucks and large commercial vehicles in residential areas of Byford.
