## "On the Beat" with Senior Sgt. Mike Newman, OIC **Mundijong Station**



Hello to all of our ewatchers.

Between the 1st and 22nd of December there was a total of 105 incidents recorded for the Mundiiona Police sub-District. Recent trends show that this continues to decrease from previous months encompassing a variety of both crime and general incidents including traffic crashes, burglaries, domestic violence, stealing and drug related activities.

We have continued to achieve a downward trend in the total monthly attempted or actual

burglaries. Statistics across our 15 suburbs/areas fell from 44 in August, 25 in September, 19 in October and to now 13 this month.

With the arrival of the summer weather and an increase in reported incidents in Byford, we will be focusing on increased patrols with the continued assistance from our South East Metro Southern Response Team based in Armadale and the dedicated Traffic Enforcement Group.

There has been an increase in stealings from parked cars in the newer residential areas in Byford and in public car parks in more remote locations such as Serpentine Falls. Please secure your car in your garage or remove your valuables from your car if left on a driveway, verge or car park.

WA Police's Community Engagement Division launched our online summer burglary project Safe as Houses.

As we are aware school has finished and the kids are now enjoying the school holidays. I want to remind parents of their responsibilities in regards to off road motor bikes. Please ensure you are supervising your children. Don't allow them to ride on the roads as this is an accident waiting to happen. Riders are not allowed to ride on private property without the permission of the owners. Be mindful of other residents. We have already received a number of complaints and both the police and Shire's rangers will be keeping an eye out for anyone who is not complying. If you choose to ignore and get caught the consequences are

serious and the motor bike will be seized.
