## "On the Beat" with Acting OIC Sgt. Bron Umbras - June 2015

Hello to all of our ewatchers,

In late June our Officer In Charge, Senior Sergeant Mike Newman, retired from a long and distinguished 37 year career in the WA Police. He was a highly respected officer both within our ranks and by many people within the community and he will be greatly missed. The process of selecting a new Officer In Charge is underway and I will continue to steer the ship in the interim.

For the month of June 2015 a total of 151 incidents were recorded for the Mundijong Police sub-District, which is on par with May 2015. This encompasses a variety of both crime and general incidents, including traffic crashes, burglaries, domestic violence, stealing and drug related activities.

The 'hot spot' for reported incidents was Byford, where we received 74 crime, traffic or general incidents, 13 in Wandi, 10 in Serpentine, 9 in Oakford and a handful for our remaining areas.

The total monthly attempted or actual burglaries across our 15 suburbs/areas halved from 31 in May to 15 in June, with Byford (9), Mundijong (3) and one each in Oldbury, Serpentine and Wandi. The arrests of several offenders, highlighted in our release last month, has certainly made an impact. Stealing offences from parked cars have continued to be of concern in June, particularly overnight in the newer residential areas in western Byford and Honeywood Estate in Wandi. We have identified and worked on three separate series of offences since April 2015.

1. On 30 June we arrested and charged a 35 year old Armadale man with eight counts of Fraud, three counts of Attempted Fraud, Stealing and Possession of Stolen Property arising from stealing from two parked cars overnight in Byford on 23 April and 3 June 2015, a great result for our efforts.

2. We are still looking for a person in relation to stealing from two parked cars overnight in Byford in early May and early June 2015.

3. Detectives and Mundijong Police are looking for a white coloured VX model Commodore sedan with distinctive hand painted grey colouring around the body in a random fashion which has been seen frequenting western Byford. On 24 April 2015 a 38 year old former Byford and Baldivis man, Corey Mander, was sentenced at Perth District Court on multiple charges, including Receiving, Fraud, Drug and Weapons offences, some arising from Burglary offences allegedly committed in Jarrahdale, Wandi, Hopeland and Golden Bay. Additional offences were committed in Byford, Oakford and Baldivis. He had been arrested on 23 December 2013, refused bail and held in custody since that time. He received a total of 2 years and 3 months imprisonment.

### Subsidised Microchipping Day - Saturday 1 August 2015

#### **CAN YOUR LOST PET GET HOME?**



A microchip may  
make a difference.

Microchips provide a record of identification for life.

**As of 1st November 2015, it is compulsory that all dogs be microchipped.**

The Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale is pleased to announce that it will be providing an opportunity for its residents to have their dogs microchipped at a discounted rate of \$30 per dog at 'Microchipping Day' to be held on Saturday 1 August 2015 between 9am-3pm at the Serpentine Jarrahdale Community Resource Centre, 2 Paterson Street, Mundijong.

Amendments made to the Dog Act 1976 in November 2013, provided that from 1 November 2015, the owner of a dog that has reached three months of age must ensure that the dog is microchipped.

This includes:-

- New dogs or pups
- Dogs being registered for the first time
- Restricted breeds or declared dangerous dogs
- Commercial security dogs

A dog is only exempt from the microchipping requirement if a veterinarian issues a certificate stating that the implantation of a microchip may adversely affect the health and welfare of the dog. When any person now registers their dog, they will be required to provide proof that their dog has been microchipped, by providing the local government with the microchip number.

We would encourage all members of the community to take advantage of this opportunity to have your dogs microchipped before the new laws come into effect.
