"On the Beat" with Senior Sgt. Mike Newman, OIC **Mundijong Station**

Hello to all of our ewatchers

During February there was a total of 185 incidents reported for the Mundijong Police Sub-District continuing a decreasing trend from previous months. This encompasses a variety of both crime and general incidents, including traffic crashes, burglaries, domestic violence, stealing and drug related activities.

The 'hot spots' for burglaries were Byford (14), Wandi (3), Oakford (4), Jarrahdale (2) and Serpentine, Mundijong, Hopelands, Darling Downs and Oldbury one each. In recent months there has been a downward trend in the total monthly attempted or actual burglaries, across our 15 suburbs/areas, however, this month this appears to be on the rise again with 30 incidents reported. The majority being committed on homes under construction with items such as hot water systems, air conditioners, ovens and cook tops being targeted. There has also been an increases in our rural areas with Oldbury, Jarrahdale, Hopelands, Darling Downs, Oakford and Serpentine figuring in the numbers. Please if you see something that appears suspicious report it on the 131444 number.

Burglaries are generally opportunistic crimes so take a little time and effort to assess your security to help you avoid becoming a victim of crime.

A 28 year old male was apprehended in the Byford area stealing property from building sites. The offender was caught "red handed" by staff from Meridian Security who were conducting some inquiries in the area as part of their "Busted" initiative. Mundijong Police attended and conducted further investigations executing a search warrant for an address in Mundijong. Subsquently a male was charged with a number of stealing offences

Nine vehicles were seized during the month for various offences such as hooning or driving whilst under suspension. Most of the seizures occurred in Byford.

There were two Fatal Traffic crashes over the past month which Major Crash are investigating and it would appear that speed may be a contributing factor. Mundijong Police have had great assistance with patrols in our area from the South East Metro Southern Response Team based in Armadale and the dedicated Traffic Enforcement Group in the Byford area, with up to eight motor bike traffic patrols conducting targeted speeding actions.

Stealings from parked cars, in the newer residential areas in Byford and public car parks in more remote locations such as Serpentine Falls continue to increase. Please don't leave your valuables in the car, secure your car in a garage where possible and lock it up.

During February we ran "Operation CAPTIVATE" which focused on the stealing from motor vehicles. Staff from Mundijong attended various locations throughout our police sub-district engaging with the community and handed out pamphlets.

Off road motor bikes seem to be rearing their heads again with complaints about unlicensed riders

driving along roads to access bush tracks to go off-road riding. This is an offence and also an extremely dangerous practise. Those riding the bikes on our roads leave themselves open to becoming involved in a traffic crash which may lead to more serious consequences. Generally the bike riders come off second best when involved in a traffic crash. Please ensure that you supervise your children. Don't allow them to ride on the roads as this is an accident waiting to happen. Riders are also not allowed to ride on private property without the permission of the owners. We have already received a number of complaints and both the police and SJ Shire rangers will be keeping an eye out for anyone who is not complying. If you choose to ignore and get caught, the consequences are serious and the motor bike will be seized. I understand that some people get a great deal of enjoyment from off-road bike riding, but you need to balance it out and have some respect for others.
