"On the Beat" with OIC Darryl Brandis - January 2016

January was a busy month for us culminating in a wonderful Australia Day citizenship ceremony and community breakfast.

I was delighted to meet so many interesting and diverse members of our community which included retired JPs and volunteers from various community groups and service clubs within the Shire.

The entertainment was first class thanks to the Heritage Country Choir and the didgeridoo playing by Mr Garlett was a highlight.



On another note local Police have been able to stem the flow of crime this month by making a large number of arrests, summonses, issuing warrants and judicial processes. Apprehension and education are key methods of changing the face of crime in this area.

Ten people were sent to court this month for motor related offences. This resulted in the seizure of vehicles and further extensions to driver's licence suspensions. Four of these offenders are likely to face incarceration if they do not curb their behaviour, some as young as 19, also face their vehicle being crushed if they re-offend.

Three people were charged with a string of stealing offences, burglaries and unlawful possession offences.

Five people who had been bailed at court and were given reporting conditions, failed to report to Police as instructed, resulting in their arrest.

A total of 70 individual charges were laid by local Police. A good result for a small team boosted by some good arrests by members of the Armadale Detectives Office, Armadale Response Team and Gosnells Local Policing Team who charged a Byford man with a number of drug and driving offences.

Of course, we are not always about punitive action and a number of people were issued with traffic infringements and cautions and work orders. On these occasions offenders may be steered away from criminal behaviour by education via the Turning Point Programme.
