## "On the Beat" with Bron Umbras, Acting OIC **Mundijong Station**

Hello to all of our ewatchers

Up until 27 October 2014, a total of 133 incidents have been recorded for the Mundijong Police sub-District. This is another decrease from 154 overall in September and 174 in August. This encompasses a variety of both crime and general incidents, including traffic crashes, burglaries, domestic violence, stealing and drug related activities.

We received 37 crime or traffic related incidents for Byford, 11 for Jarrahdale (including a few traffic crashes on the Albany and South Western Highways), 10 each for Oakford, Serpentine, Mundijong and Casuarina, 9 for Cardup and a few for our remaining areas. The remainder of the total relates to general incidents.

The 'hot spots' for burglaries were Byford 4, Mundijong 3 and Whitby and Wandi 2 each. Resulting from a number of search warrants being issues and arrests being made in the last six weeks, we have achieved a cut in the total attempted or actual burglaries across our 15 suburbs/areas from 44 in August, to 25 in September and now almost at the end of the October to 15. In particular, the number of attempted or actual burglaries in Byford has been reduced from 15 in August, to 10 in September and now 4 to date for October.

We are proud of these achievements which have been undertaken, not only by officers from our station, but with invaluable assistance from Armadale and Mandurah Detectives and the dedicated South East Metro Southern Response Team based from Armadale.

With the summer weather almost here, we have noticed an increase in stealings from parked cars, both in the newer residential areas in Byford and Oakford and public car parks in more remote locations. Please try to secure your car in a garage or remove valuables from your vehicle if left in a driveway, verge or car park.

Following on from the arrest of a 37 year old Oakford man for the burglary at Nushine Car Wash in Byford last month, he has pleaded guilty and will have a pre-sentence report compiled for 11 November 2014. On 6 October 2014 we charged him with another alleged burglary in Karrakup around that time and he has been remanded in custody until early December 2014.

On 7 October 2014 we charged a 44 year old Shoalwater man with the burglary of Advanced Autologic in Byford in July 2014. He was released on a substantial bail undertaking with strict night time curfew conditions, which he allegedly breached on his first check and is now wanted for arrest.

On 5 October 2014, in conjunction with the Shire of Serpentine-Jarrahdale's Neighbourhood Watch, we held a Marquee Display at the Jarrahdale Log Chop and allowed people to have a good look inside our Police vehicles. On 14, 21 and 28 October 2014 we held BBQ sausage sizzles & kids activities with the Shire staff, Neighbourhood Watch and the YMCA Youth Team in Serpentine, Jarrahdale and Oakford respectively. All events were a great success. In partnership with the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale's Community Services staff and Neighbourhood Watch volunteers we will be holding further displays, BBQs and kids activities in Keysbrook, Mundijong and Byford 4,11 and 21 November respectively.
