## "On the Beat" with Acting OIC Charlie Moylan - October 2015

During October Mundijong Police recorded over 180 incidents that involved varying degrees of police investigation, with 50% of the reports relating to the Byford area.

There were over 80 offences relating to burglary and stealing reports requiring resources from the Mundijong Local Policing Team, District Forensics and the South East Metro Southern Response Team all contributing to keeping offences down and apprehensions up.

Promoting the good work of the Mundijong station this month, results from the station are as follows:-

- Mundijong - Police charged a local man with burglary and theft from the Centrals Football Club
- Mundijong – Four stolen vehicles were recovered from a property in Tonkin Street. Two adult males and two teenagers were identified for a string of alleged burglaries and thefts and were arrested and charged.
- Byford – a 27 year old Byford man was held in custody for assaulting two police officers.
- Byford – a 22 year old local man was arrested for breaching bail and for the theft of four CCTV cameras and theft and fraudulent use of a cash card.
- Byford – a 42 year old local woman was charged with burglary and theft and also drug offences.
- Byford – a 24 year old Oakford man was arrested and charged on drug related issues.
- Oldbury – a 37 year old Thornlie man was arrested for reckless driving and driving with a suspended licence.
- Serpentine – a 17 year old male was arrested and charged with criminal damage, motor vehicle theft, damage and graffiti offences.
- Jarrahdale – a 40 year old Pinjarra man was arrested for a string of serious offences including burglary and assault, ramming a Police vehicle and failing to stop.

These results are a sample of the investigations that our staff conduct which can be quite protracted and can affect our Local Policing Team's availability. Be assured that we treat all matters as important. ## Trail Bike and Off Road Vehicle Blitz

A Joint Agency Enforcement/Education Operation was conducted on Saturday 17 and Sunday 18 October 2015. The operation involved officers from the Water Corporation, Department of Parks and Wildlife, WA Police (Mundijong station) and the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale.

Preliminary figures show 78 motorcycles and all terrain vehicles were identified over the two days. Written and verbal warnings were issued by the four agencies.

The operation was considered to be a significant success, with all but one person cooperative. Riders were referred to off-road vehicle organisations and user groups, and informed about areas where they can legally operate their off-road vehicles.



Police checked vehicle VINS. There were no stolen vehicles identified, with many of the operators appreciating the checks being done. Police were also able to patrol the area and gather intelligence relating to ongoing matters.
