On behalf of the Councillors and staff at the City of Kwinana, I'd like to begin by wishing you all a Happy New Year! I trust you had a wonderful Christmas with family and friends and came into 2016 refreshed and rejuvenated, ready to hit some goals this year. The City of Kwinana has come into 2016 with some exciting projects and events in sight.

### **Adventure Playground**

Work has begun on the Kwinana Adventure Playground and we expect to deliver the finished product by the end of this year. This playground will be like no other in our City (and region) and we hope it will be a welcome addition for families in the area. The \$5.2 million playground will boast a splash pad, picnic hub, music and educational elements, all-inclusive play, barbeque facilities, elevated walkways, a super slide, flying fox and water-spray wall alongside traditional playground elements such as swings, slides and sand. The playground will also feature additional parking and amenities and best of all – it's free! The playground is just a short drive across the freeway to Calista in Kwinana's City Centre.

### **Australia Day**

The City will celebrate Australia Day in true Aussie style with a free community BBQ, entertainment, Premier's Award presentation, Citizenship Ceremony and activities for the whole family to enjoy. Join us on 26 January 9am - 12noon on the Council Green outside the Administration Building, corner of Gilmore Avenue and Sulphur Road in Kwinana.

### **Neighbour Day**

Once again, the City will be supporting those in the community who would like to host an event or get together on Neighbour Day – Sunday, 3 April. This will also coincide with Wandî's "The Pavilion" official opening. Neighbour Day is a national initiative to help foster relationships within the community and the City is supporting local meet-ups with donations of \$150 towards refreshments to the first six registrants. Plus, all those who register their event by 18 March will receive Neighbour Day packs to help promote their event, which can range from a casual barbeque in the local park to a street gathering. ## **AROUND THE WANDI COMMUNITY CENTRE**

Those residents in Wandí who have been following the goings on at the Wandí Community Centre would see that the new Pavilion is up and running but not quite finished. With the building hand-over so close to Xmas, it made the final works difficult to be completed, however by the time you read this we should have a concrete path around the building and a new pram ramp off the car park that will also serve as a disabled ramp. Following this will be the construction of drainage to the rear of the tennis courts and then the reticulation and grassing of the area between the front of the building and the limestone carpark. We have requested Council only plant low trees around the edge of the carparks and keep the rest as lawn as most clubs will find this more useful than gardens. A future addition will be a free electric BBQ sited to suit users of the Pavilion and Equestrian Centre. Other BBQ's on site are well used by clubs and the public.

We have a couple of new groups using the facilities and they would be happy to see new members attend their group. Glen Lachlann Estate College of Arms (GLECA) has a small article in the Warbler that explains what they do, please read. Classes are on every Thursday from the 4<sup>th</sup> February 7pm. We also have KONGA fitness classes starting on the 10 February from 6.30 – 7.30pm both groups contact details appear in this edition. Please make use of all the groups because if they don't get good attendance they can't run and we lose a great asset for Wandí.

The Pavilion official opening will be our next major community activity and you are all welcome to attend. We expect it to be a community facilities open day where you can wander around and check out what's on offer and stay for a feed and a bit of music.

What's on the agenda for the rest of 2016? Well because of the location of The Pavilion, we have been meeting regularly with the Equestrian Management Committee and both groups have identified the access to the Community site as being a problem. Therefore we have been working with the City of Kwinana to rectify this by adding a new exit/entry point and the formalising of the large limestone carpark in front of the Pavilion. We will have to wait and see what happens but we are hopeful something will be done even if it is completed in stages.

### **LANDCARE UPDATE**

The Wandí area has seen lots of changes over the years, none so much as the new urban development of Honeywood. This has introduced many more people into the area and an added challenge to engage new residents to get involved. Working with Satterley Property Group and the newly formed Honeywood Residents Group, the Wandí Landcare Group has been involved with night stalks for the past three years. The children always enjoy finding interesting creatures in the natural areas around the estate such as frogs and scorpions. In November the WLCG held a frog pond workshop which was a great success. Children and parents got dirty and built a frog pond and bog. A lot of fun was had learning about the native frogs of the area and how to build habitat to support the wildlife in an urban area.

In 2015 the WLCG supported the City of Kwinana's funding application for 2016 State NRM Community Action Grant – Feral Animal Control Priorities and Significant Fauna Survey of Kwinana Bushland Reserves. Wandí is known for its natural surrounds that support a variety of wildlife. The community educational component of the proposal will be vital to raise awareness of the community about the local wildlife and threats from feral animals. The WLCG is also interested in assisting with surveys around the natural areas of Wandí

and organising a nightstalk in the Lake Magenup dampland area. This will provide WPA members the opportunity to see how well the re-vegetation work has provided improved habitat for local wildlife.

The WLCG also applied for the funding to continue on-ground works at Lake Magenup dampland, in conjunction with the City of Kwinana for the Swan Alcoa Landcare Program 2015 funding round. This will continue the eight years of revegetation work the group has been doing each year at the annual community tree planting day. A huge thanks to Angela Jakob for organising the grant each year and working with WLCG in coordinating the tree planting.

The City of Kwinana hosted its annual 'End of Year Volunteer Thank You Afternoon Tea' at Sloans Reserve to thank the volunteers who do various Landcare activities throughout Kwinana. Representatives from WLCG received certificates of appreciation and Catherine provided a brief summary of all our activities this year.

This year the group will be doing some more seed collecting - meeting at the Community Centre **Sunday 31 January at 9am**. - Represented 'Legends' team versus Perth Scorchers in the Festival of Cricket match in 2014
- Represented Australia Under 19's – toured Sri Lanka and England; home series against England
- Spent three months at the Cricket Australia Academy in 2015

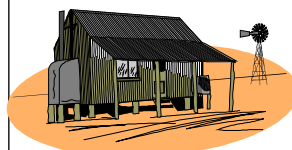
